THE TASTING PANEL

Barrel-fermented with native yeast and then aged entirely in French oak (30% of which was new), this embodies so much of what makes Flowers the respected producer it is: Generosity, minerality, and acidity exist side-by-side, lending balance to the notes of ripe Seckel pears, caramelized nectarines, and a passing hint of pie crust – an ideal bass note against which almond blossoms rise.

Rich aromas of ripe black cherry and blood-orange are dusted with earthy spice and find lift with subtly perfumed notes of citrus oil and incense. These follow through to the velvet-textured palate, whose spine of minerality lingers through the long, detailed finish. Delicious both on its own and at the table.
